

Families and Communities Together, Inc. is an independent, local non-profit organization serving families and children throughout all 12 communities of Marion County. FACT's mission is to facilitate collaborative action to improve lives in our county, recognizing that children live, learn, and thrive in safe, healthy homes, schools, and communities. FACT partners with Marion County churches, Marion County school districts, and agencies throughout the county in its endeavors to serve. FACT is the parent organization for the following task forces, coalitions, and programs:

- Early Childhood Task Force: coordinating over 20 agencies, organizations, and programs to assist Marion County families in meeting the needs of their young children by insuring that the totality of the child—safety, nutrition, physical and mental health, familial support, societal inclusion, childcare, play—is nurtured.
- Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition: supporting the prevention of underage drinking and substance abuse in Marion County by doing what works to make positive change in our communities. We have been awarded the KDADS/KPCCI Substance Abuse Prevention Grant to design strategic plans to effectively combat drinking and substance abuse among Marion County youth.
- Family Financial Assistance Network: helping sustain families through emergency financial situations (rent, utilities, catastrophic fires or floods, medical emergencies, etc.).
- Dolly Parton Imagination Library: Marion County chapter of the Dollywood Foundation book gifting program that mails free books to children (birth to age five) of participating families in Marion County communities.
- It Takes a Village... Early Childhood Collaborative: Because children don't come with instructions, the ITAV project utilizes all the tools and resources at our disposal to offer evidence-based, collaborative services to at-risk families and children by providing early childhood screenings, mental health consultations, parenting classes, childcare provider professional development, Parent Cafés, and preschool scholarships to foster healthy development, build strong family connections, and promote early learning.
- Resourcing and Referrals: FACT provides the primary Resource and Referral program in Marion County. We are responsible for organizing and printing the Marion County Family Resource Directory and distributing the books throughout the county in schools, city buildings, health department, hospitals, clinics, doctor's offices, etc. If a family has a need of any kind, FACT can refer them to an agency that can help them.
